Pumpkin Muffins

1/3 cup canola oil
1/3 cup applesauce
2 2/3 cup granulated Splenda
1 cup of Eggbeaters
16 ozs. unsweetened pumpkin
2/3 cup nonfat yogurt
1 2/3 cup whole wheat flour
1 cup white flour
2/3 cup wheat germ or flax seed
2 tsp. baking soda
1/2 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp cinnamon
1 tsp. ground cloves
(may add raisins)

Combine oil, applesauce, Splenda, Eggbeaters, pumpkin, yogurt and wheat germ, in large bowl, mix on medium till well blended. Add remainder of ingredients and mix just until flour is blended in. Fill muffin pans 3/4 full. Bake at 350° for 20-30 minutes. 24 muffins. 66 calories.

The latest research by Italian scientists indicates that drinking wine can help prevent tooth decay, gum disease and sore throats.

Both red and white wines contain powerful germ-killing ingredients. Drinking a glass of wine regularly can act as an effective agent against disease-causing streptococci bacteria and upper respiratory tract infections, according to a study published in the American Journal of Agricultural and Food Chemistry.
