## **BIG** News!

Big news from the American Heart
Association: most patients who previously
required antibiotic pre-medication prior to
receiving dental care may no longer need
those antibiotics. New evidence shows the
risks outweigh the benefits for most patients.
The updated recommendations say that
only those who are at the greatest risk for
complications from infective endocarditis,
an infection of the heart's inner lining or
heart valves, should receive preventive
antibiotics before routine dental procedures.
If you have been taking protective antibiotics
in the past, please contact your physician for
his/her current recommendation.

If you think your schedule is too hectic to take time to visit the dentist for a cleaning and examination, consider the following:

In 2005, Pope Benedict XVI was approaching the end of the morning session of a synod of bishops at the Vatican, when Archbishop Nikola Eterovic made an announcement that the afternoon session was scheduled to begin at 4:30 PM, to which the Pope could be heard on closed circuit TV, "I have an appointment with the dentist at 4 PM." ## Dentists: The New Superdocs?



- Within 5 years your dental checkup may be a first line of defense against breast cancer. Four proteins in saliva, being studied at the University of Texas, may serve as early signs of the disease; rising levels could prompt an MRI or a mammogram.
- New software from European scientists uses dental x-rays to gauge osteoporosis risk. It's as accurate as bone-density tests in early trials and may be in dentists' offices within two years.
- Peppermint toothpaste packed with cocoa powder extract, developed at Tulane University, will be available in 2 to 4 years. The extract prevents tooth decay more effectively than fluoride, making teeth harder and less susceptible to plaque.
